

**CITY OF BRACKETTVILLE
RESOLUTION NO. 2026-05 -12 WCP**

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A WATER CONSERVATION PLAN FOR THE CITY OF BRACKETTVILLE CONSISTENT WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY; ESTABLISHING WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION, MONITORING, AND ENFORCEMENT; FINDING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Of Brackettville owns and operates a public water supply system for the benefit of its residents and customers; and

WHEREAS, the City Of Brackettville recognizes that water is a limited and essential natural resource requiring careful management and conservation; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has promulgated guidelines and requirement for retail public water suppliers to adopt and implement water conservation plans; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that adoption of a Water Conservation Plan is necessary to promote efficient use of water resources, reduce waste, extend water supplies, and protect public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brackettville, Texas desires to adopt a resolution for that purpose;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRACKETTVILLE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF WATER CONSERVATION PLAN.

The City Council of the City of Brackettville, Texas hereby adopts the Cybersecurity Plan as set forth in Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference. which is subject to changes or amendments as determined by the City Council.

SECTION 2. OPEN MEETING

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution is passed is open to the public as required by law and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY

If any section, part, or provision of this Resolution is declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then, in that event, it is expressly provided, and it is the intention of the City Council in passing this Resolution that its parts shall be severable, and all other parts of this Resolution shall not be affected thereby and they shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

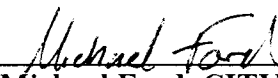
This Resolution becomes effective immediately after being passed and approved.
